



Dr. Heinz Egge (Former Director of the Institute of Physiological Chemistry at the University Clinics of the University of Bonn) sadly passed away on March 28, 2022. May he rest in peace.

Dr. H. Egge had characterized a huge number of the structures of human milk oligosaccharides as well as sugar chains of gangliosides and glycoproteins with the techniques of high - resolution NMR and mass spectroscopies. He was a pioneer of the study field through glycochemistry to glycobiology.
